

WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY : EFFECTIVE DATE: 1-NOV-2007, revised 8-AUG-2020

SUMMARY:

MyMusicianship is a website produced by the company SonicFit. MyMusicianship collects names, email addresses, and passwords of both students and instructors. All passwords are fully encrypted and not visible to anyone. Email addresses are used for logging in and updating password if a user forgets their password. Student names are visible to instructors for the purpose of identifying their account and progress in the site. NO information is ever shared with any other company.

MyMusicianship does NOT use 3rd party cookies. We do store site data (session storage) on user computer for site functionality. Session storage is deleted when the site's browser window is closed.

In setting up an instructor account, schools with students under the age of 13 assume legal responsibility for obtaining the consent of a parent or legal guardian for using student names, emails, and passwords.

1. PURPOSE OF POLICY. SONICFIT ("us," "we," or "Company") is committed to respecting the privacy rights of its customers, visitors, and other users of the Company Websites SonicFit.com and MyMusicianship.com (the "Site"). We created this Website Privacy Policy (this "Policy") to give you confidence as you visit and use the Site, and to demonstrate our commitment to fair information practices and the protection of privacy. This Policy is only applicable to the Site.

2. INFORMATION COLLECTION PRACTICES

2.1. WHAT BASIC INFORMATION DOES THE COMPANY COLLECT?

In operating the Site, Company includes registration that ask users to provide their names, institutional affiliation, e-mail addresses, and settings they desire for the site.

2.2. WHAT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION DOES COMPANY COLLECT?

(a) AUTOMATIC COLLECTION. Our servers automatically recognize visitors' domain names and IP addresses (the number assigned to computers on the Internet). No personal information about you is revealed in this process. The Site may also gather anonymous "traffic data" that does not personally identify you.

(b) COOKIES and CACHE. We use the standard "cookies", "cache", and "session

storage” feature of major browser applications that allows us to store small pieces of data on your computer to improve your computer’s speed and performance using the Site. While Site’s login features require the use of cookies, we do not set any personally identifiable information in any cookies, nor do we employ any data capture mechanisms on our website other than cookies. You can choose whether to accept cookies by changing the settings on your browser. However, if you choose to disable this function, some features of the Site will not work and your experience will be diminished.

(c) SITE INFORMATION accumulated by the user, their score reports and weekly logs, are associated with the students account and visible to the user and the instructor only.

(d) OTHER INFORMATION – there are no features for students to share other information. There are no chat or correspondence tools on the site.

3. USE AND SHARING OF INFORMATION

3.1. WHAT DOES COMPANY DO WITH COLLECTED INFORMATION?

(a) PERSONAL INFORMATION. We will not share your personal information with any third parties without your consent, except as necessary to comply with the law. We may use your personal information to verify your identity, to check your qualifications, or to follow up with transactions initiated on the Site. We may also use your contact information to inform you of any changes to the Site affecting your account.

(b) ANONYMOUS INFORMATION. We may use anonymous information to analyze our Site traffic, but we do not examine this information for individually identifying information. In addition, we may use anonymous IP addresses to help diagnose problems with our server, to administer our site, or to display the content according to your preferences.

(c) USE OF COOKIES. We use cookies, cache, and session storage to deliver content specific to your use of the site, to save your password so you don't have to re-enter it each time you visit our site, or for other purposes specific to the functionality of the Site.

(d) DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION. We may disclose personal information if required to do so by law or in the good-faith belief that such action is necessary to (1) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Company, (2) protect and defend the rights or property of Company or the users of the Site, or (3) act under exigent circumstances to protect the safety of the public or users of the Site.

(e) ACCESS TO INFORMATION. Instructors have access to the information students provide when the register, including a registration name and email

address. SONICFIT accepts no liability for actions of the instructor with this information. Instructors and students may request that we remove all information about them from our database by contacting us in accordance with Section 6.1 below.

4. SECURITY

The Site has security measures in place to prevent the loss, misuse, and alteration of the information that we obtain from you, but we make no assurances about our ability to prevent any such loss, misuse, to you or to any third party arising out of any such loss, misuse, or alteration.

5. WEBSITE AREAS BEYOND COMPANY'S CONTROL

5.1. PUBLIC FORUMS

The Site contains NO interactive forums such as message boards or chat.

5.2. THIRD PARTY WEBSITES

The Site may contain links to other websites. If you choose to visit other websites, we are not responsible for the privacy practices or content of those other websites, and it is your responsibility to review the privacy policies at those websites to confirm that you understand and agree with their policies.

7 NOTICE CONCERNING CHILDREN

We are a general audience site, and do not direct any of our content

specifically at children under 13 years of age. In compliance with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act ("COPPA"), the Site may only be used by children under 13 years old as a part of a school subscription in which the consent of your parent or legal guardian has been obtained by your school.

In registering a school subscription, we require that the school (a) obtains verifiable parental consent with regard to every Child that will use the Site and (b) consents (on behalf of the parents/legal guardians) to the collection, use and disclosure of personal information of the Child, through the Site, in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

At any time, we will remove a student's personal information if If we learn or have reason to suspect that a Site user under age 13 does not have parental permission, we will promptly delete any personal information in that user's account. Parents of record according to the school may, at any time, request that we remove all information about their child from our database by contacting us in accordance with Section 6.1 above.
